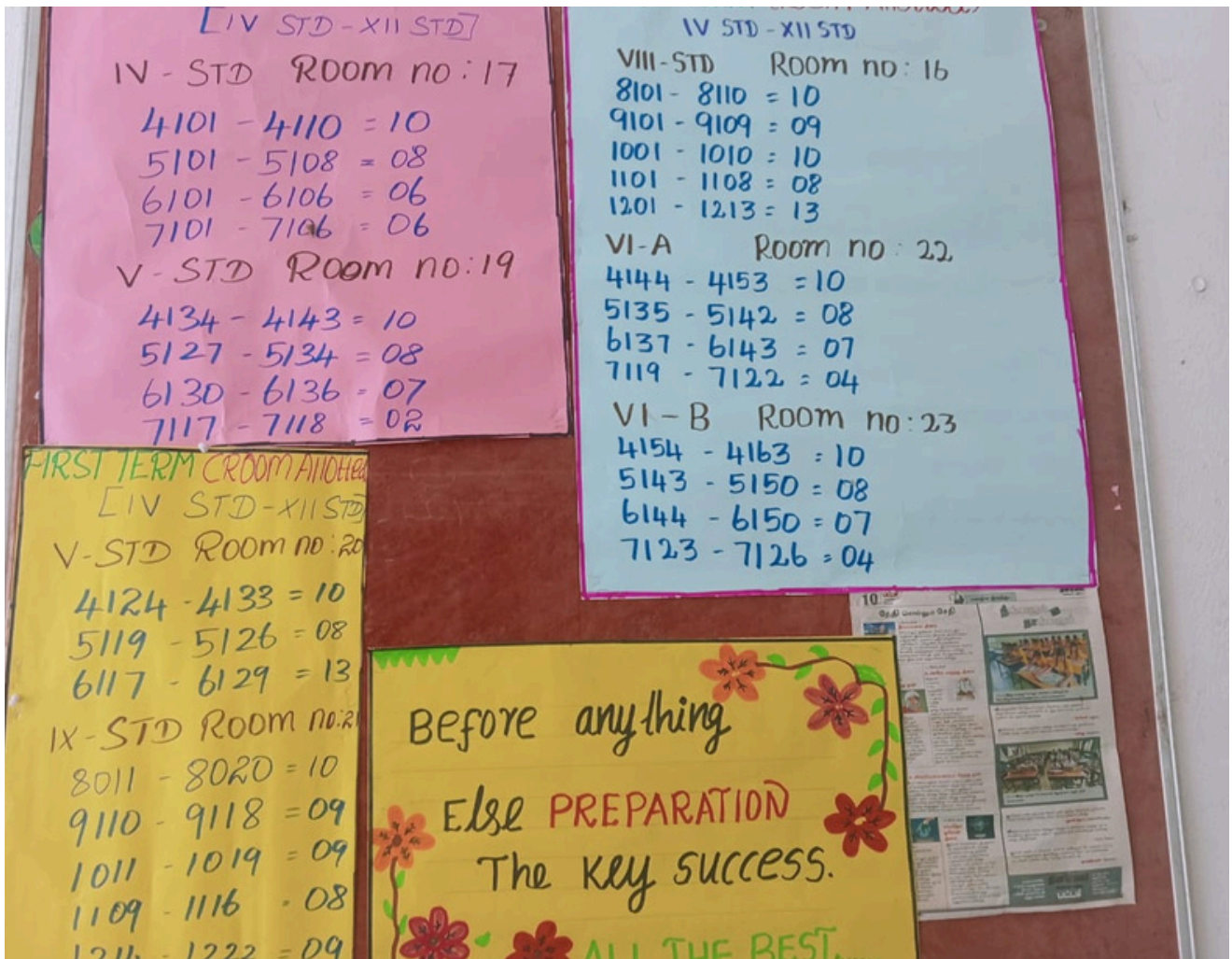
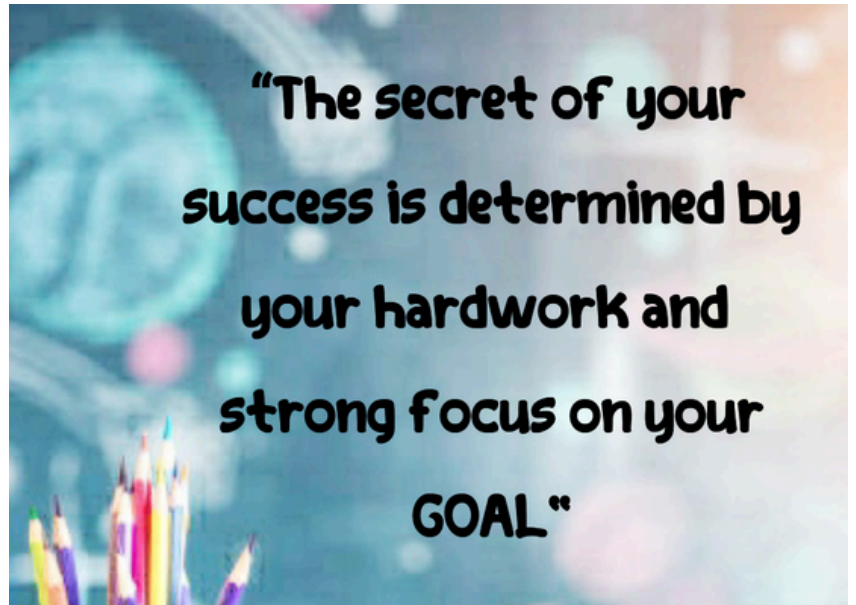
The timetable was prepared well in advance and communicated to all the students and parents, ensuring adequate preparation time for students.

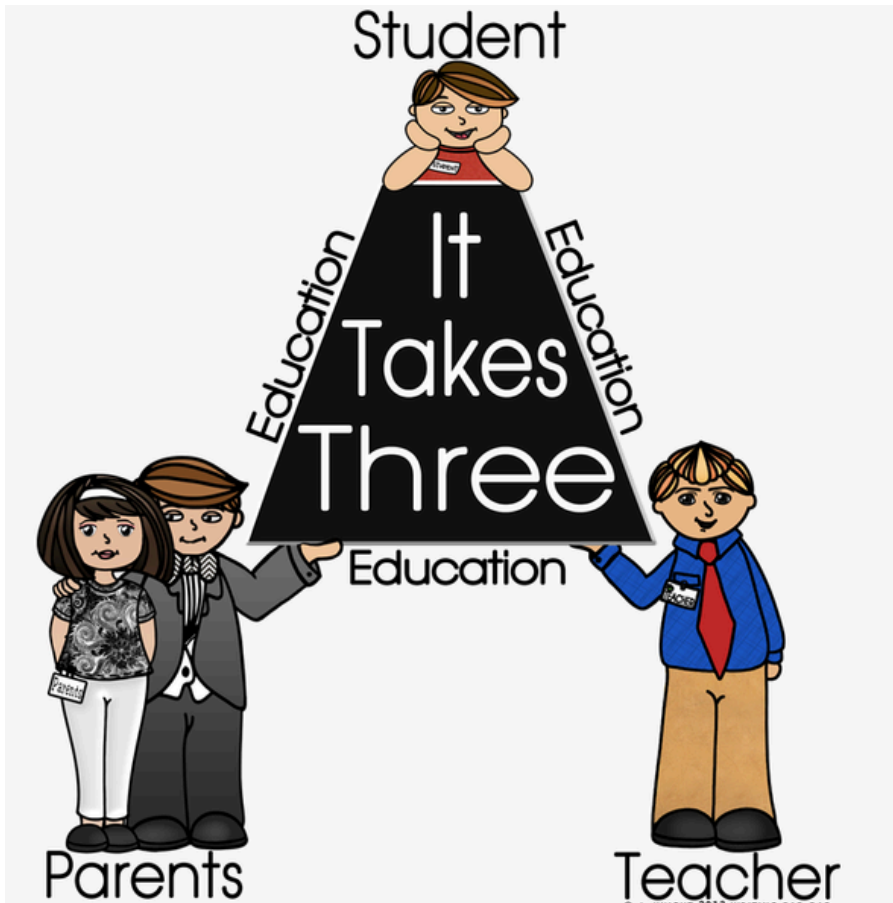
