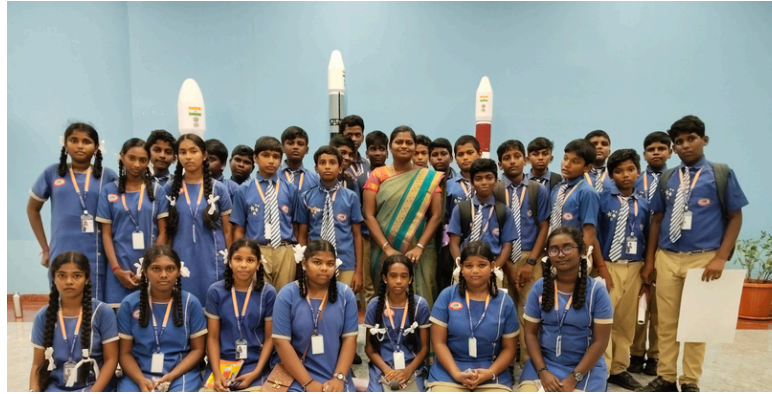

Reaching for the stars: Our Students witness a rocket launch at ISRO



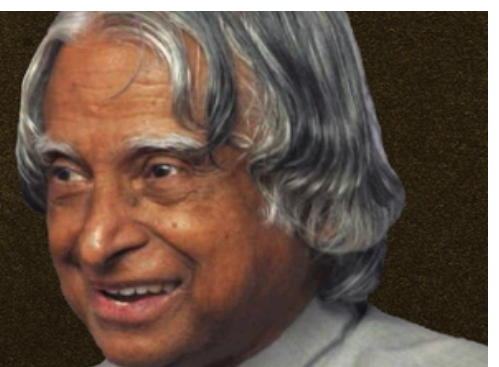

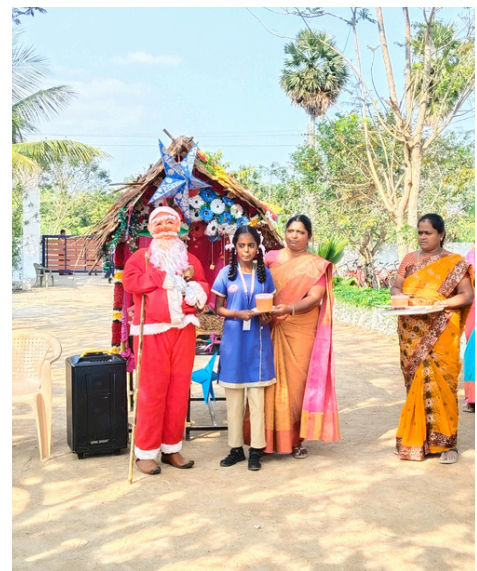
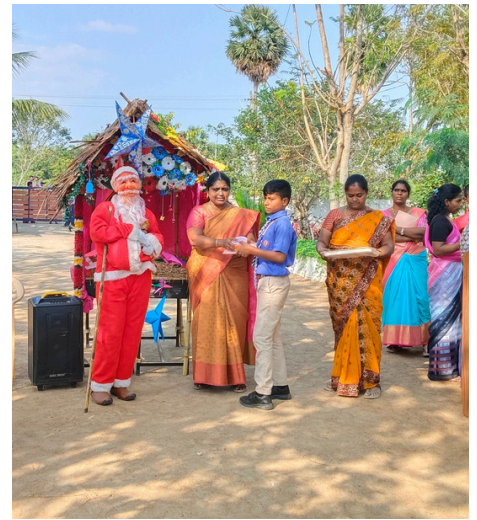
A beautiful skit followed by a melodious carols sung by the choir.

Our children are given exposure to various extra curricular activities, as we understand the need and significance of shaping the children into multifaceted personalities, in simple words a successful all-rounder.

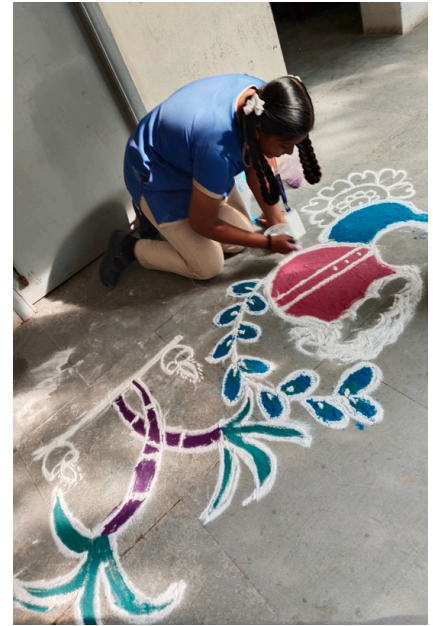
