A Fresh Start: Back to school After the Break!

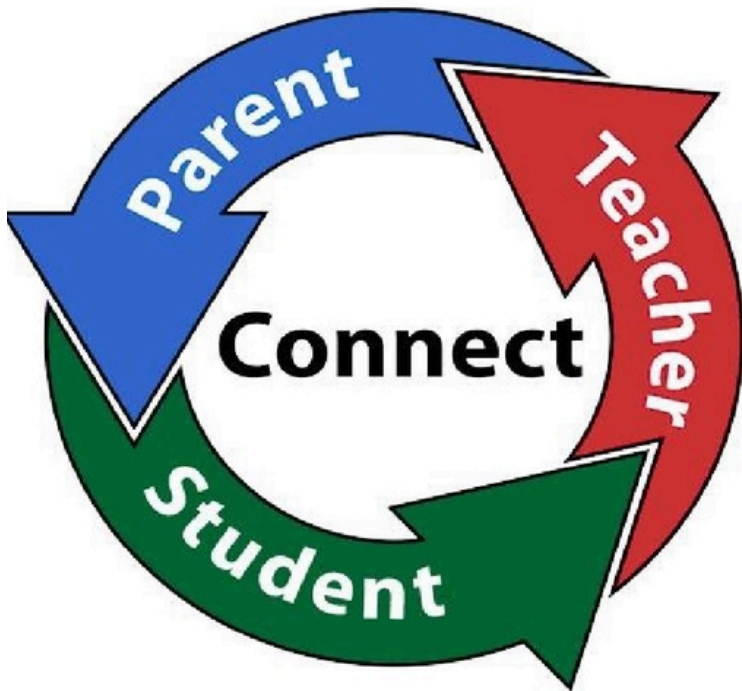

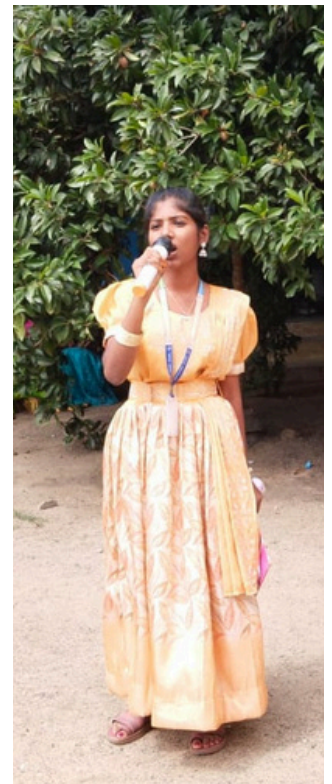
"Harvesting Joy: A Festive Symphony of Culture and Togetherness"
