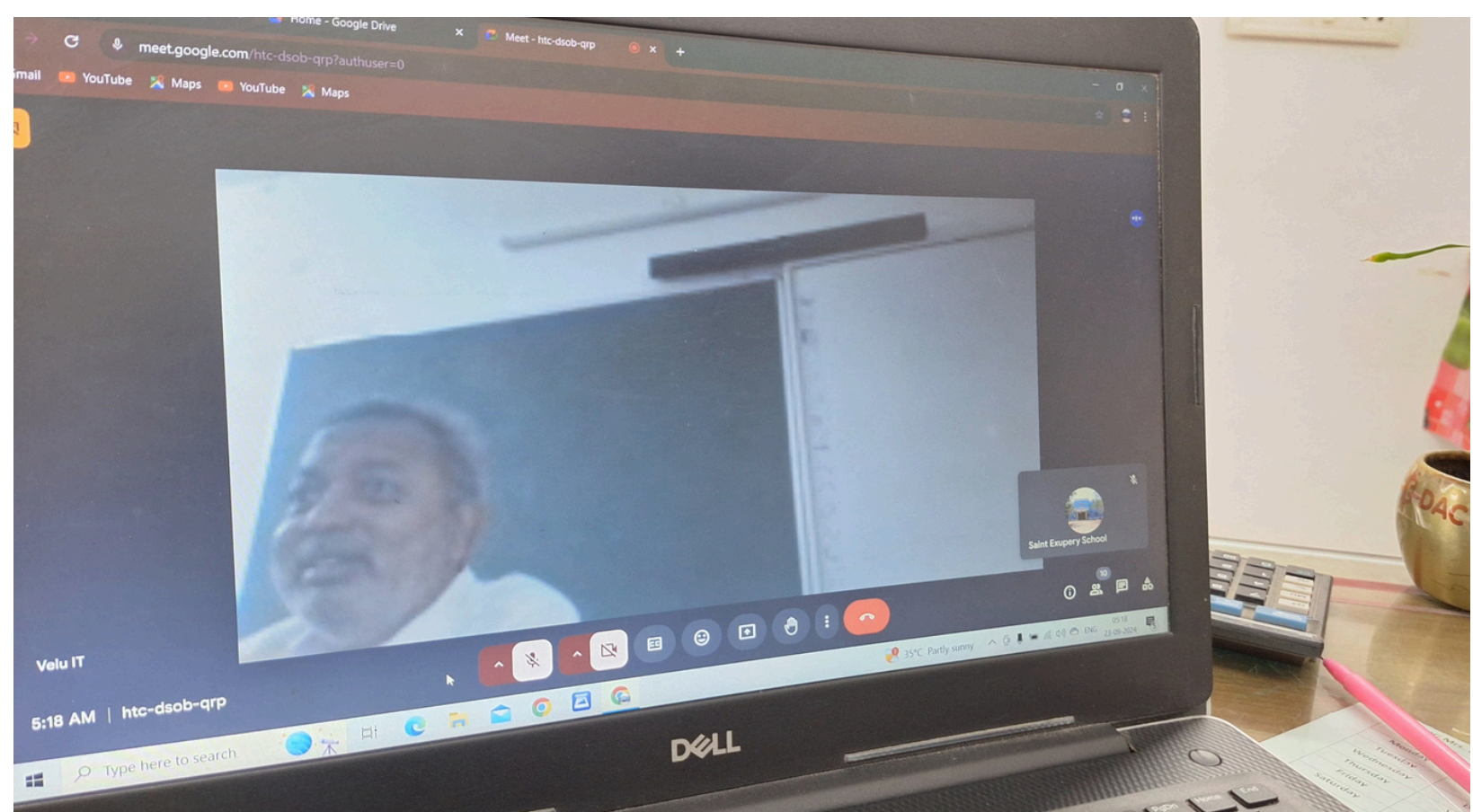
# Online Training Session on Child Protection Policy and Core Values

The session was a success, leaving the staff well-informed, motivated, and aligned in their commitment to upholding safety, values, and ethics within the school community.

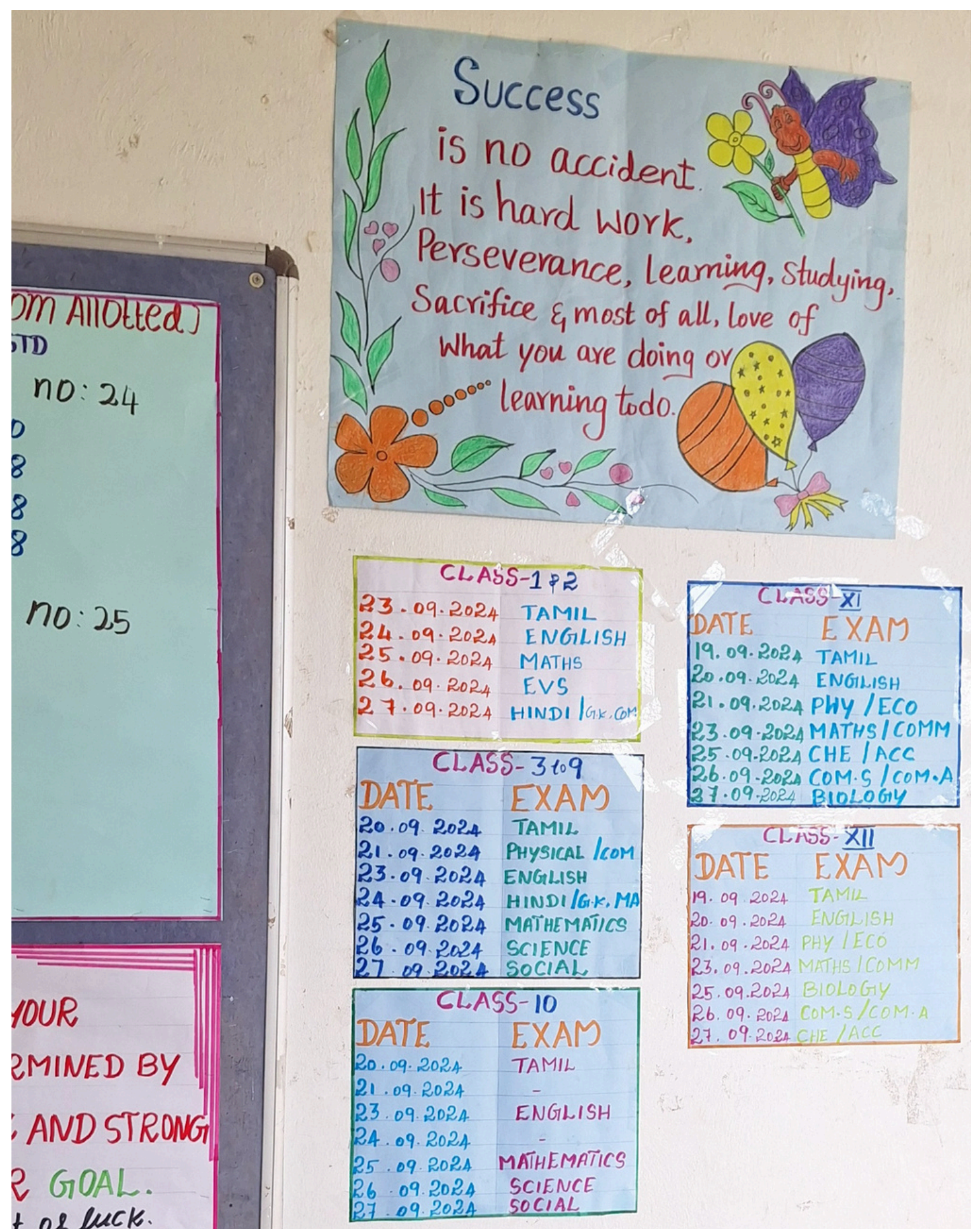
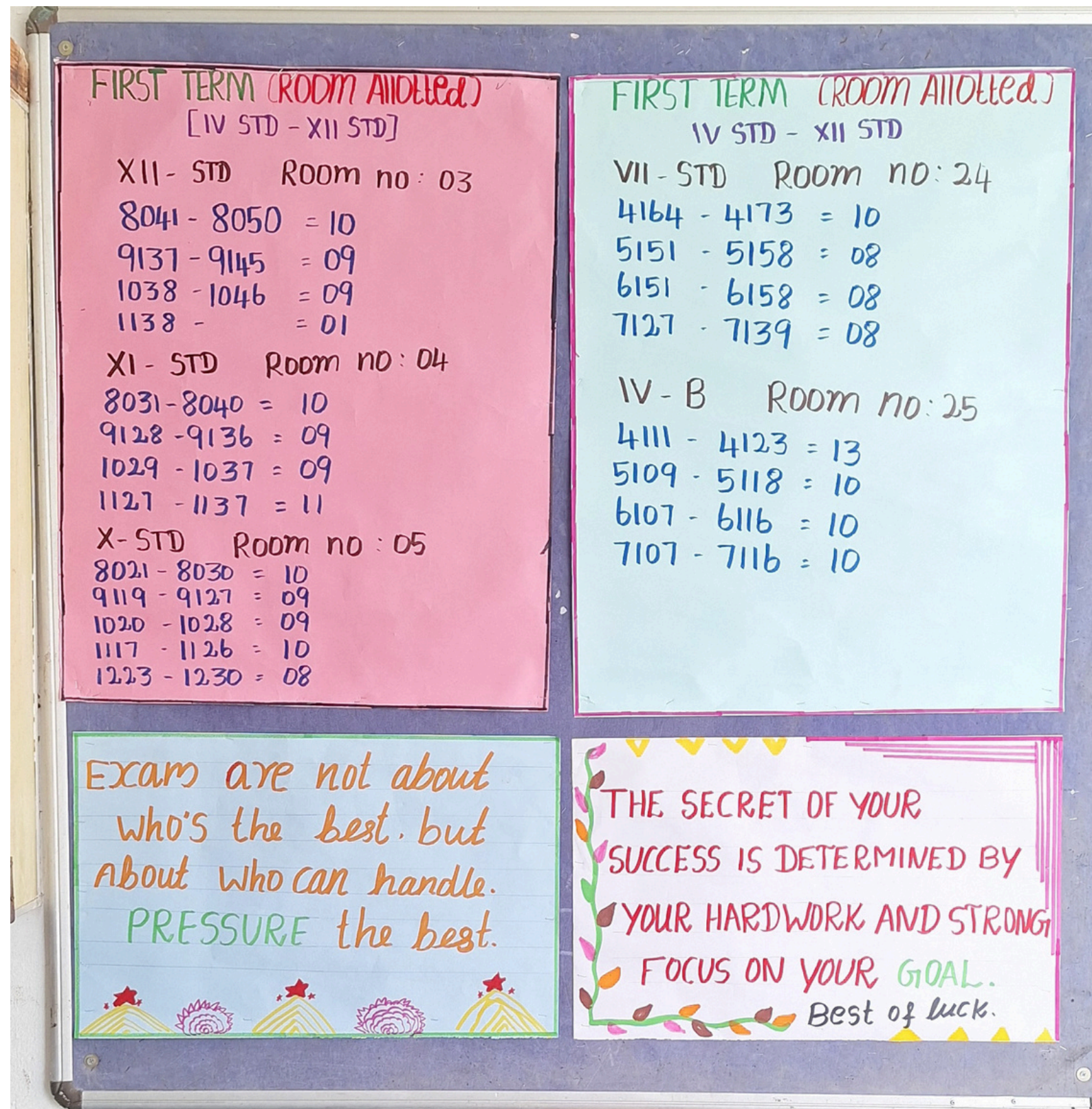


# Quarterly Examinations: A Step Towards Academic Excellence
