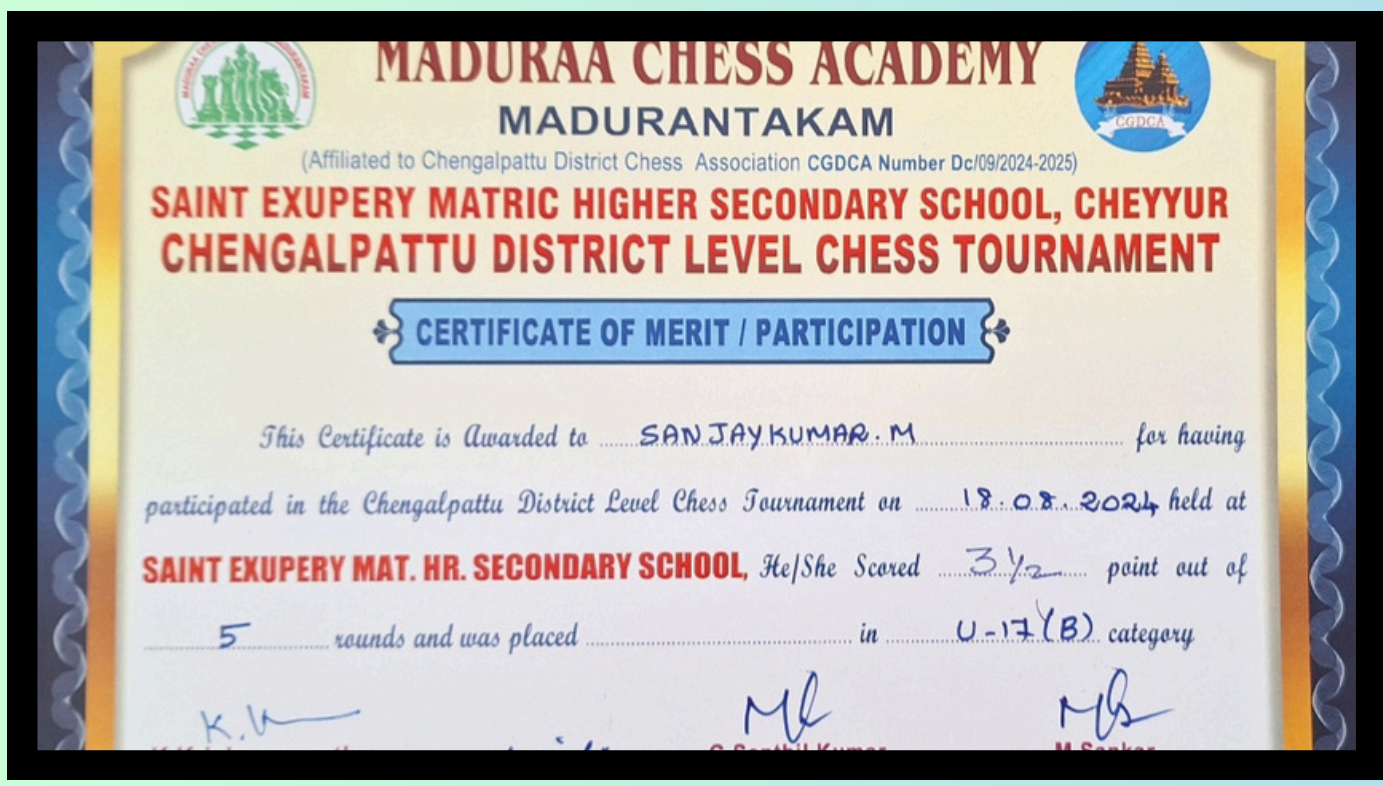
The tournament saw participation from approximately 160 students representing various schools in the district. Over the course of five challenging rounds, competitors demonstrated their skills and determination on the chessboard.
