she also highlighted the importance of spending a few minutes daily with their children, asking them about their day and what they learned at school, to help improve their memory power.

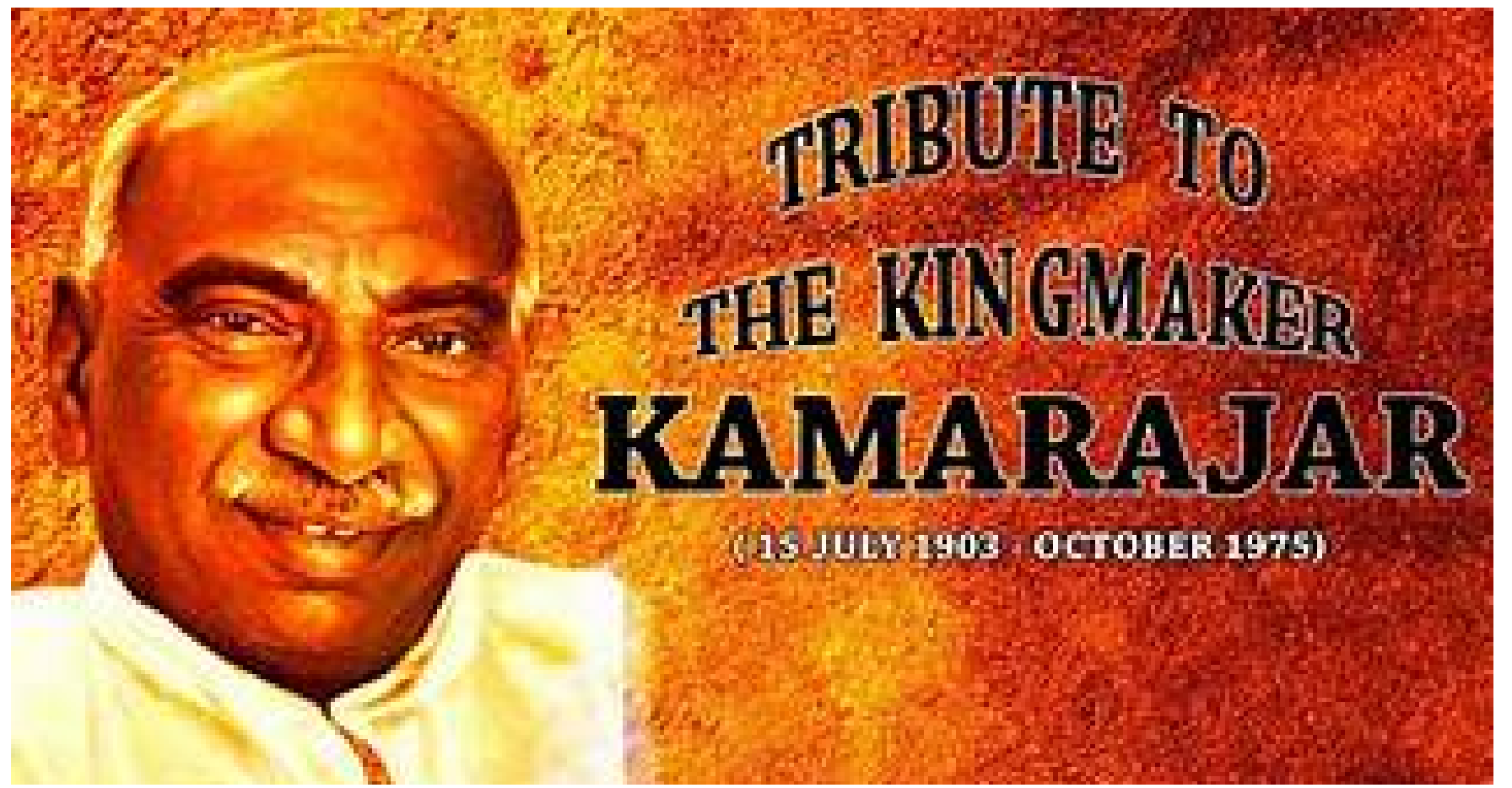
Closing Remarks:

Karmaverar Kamarajar's Birthday & Educational Development Day Celebration

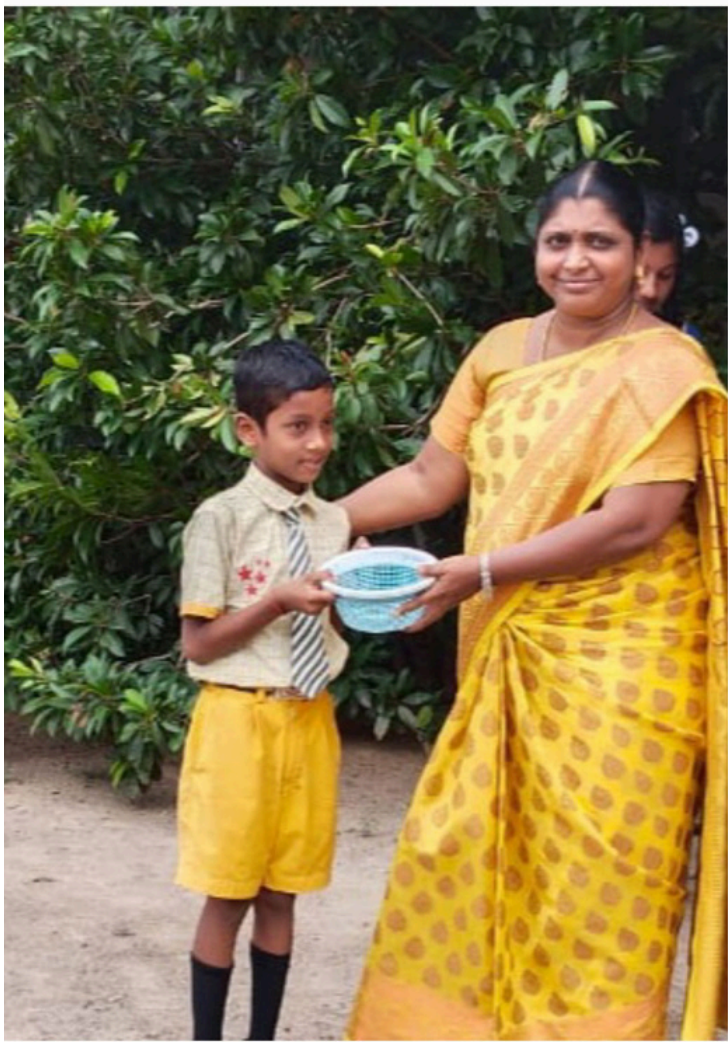
