To make the first day back extra special, KG teachers organized a series of fun and engaging activities like travelling on the kid’s train, photo corner, building blocks, puzzle game etc...



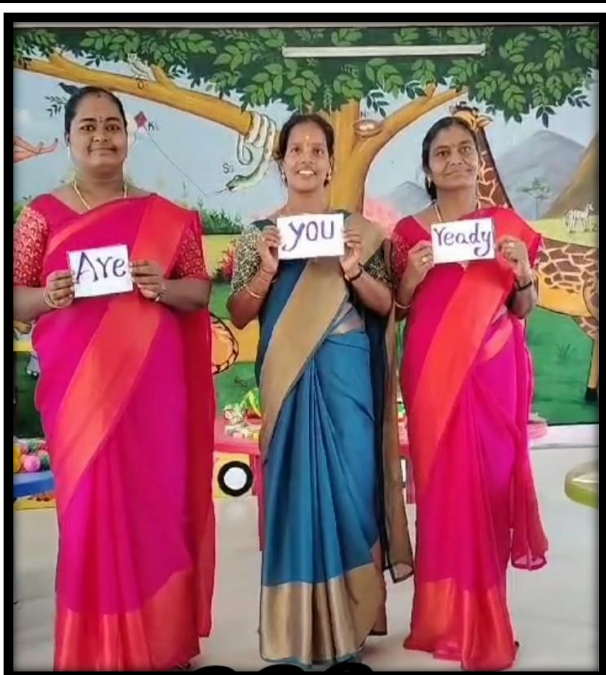

We also took a moment to acknowledge and thank our students for their remarkable achievement in the 10th board exam

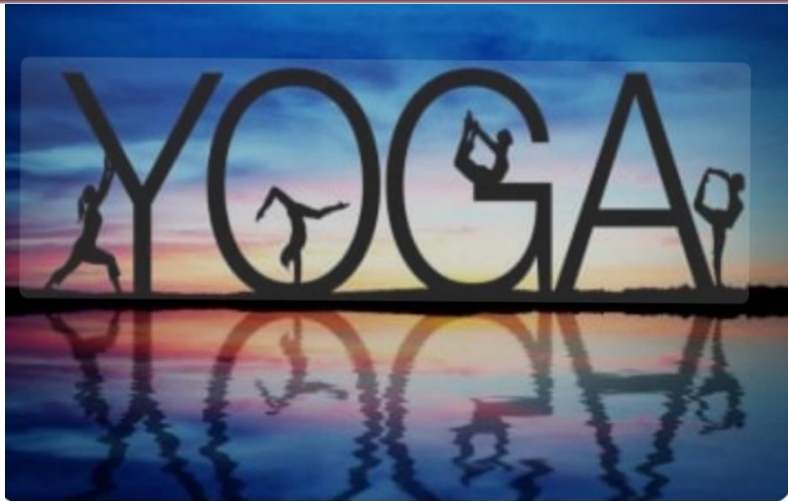
results. Their hard work, dedication, and perseverance have set a high standard, and we are incredibly proud of their accomplishments.

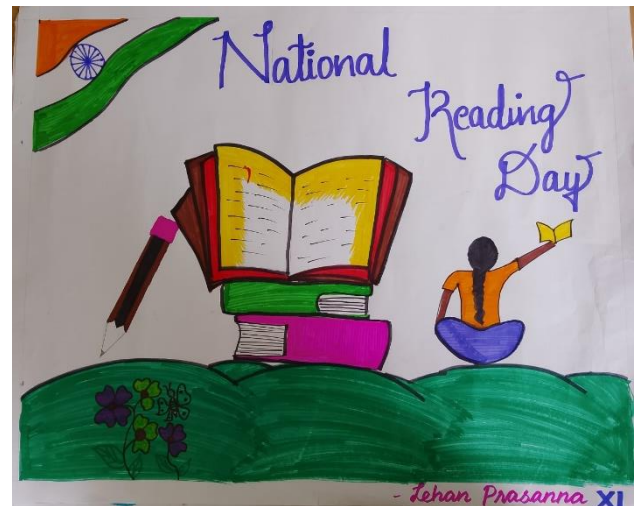
